Students must ...

- Be a permanent resident or citizen of the United States
- Be a resident of Bergen or Passaic County, NJ
- Have a cumulative GPA of 2.75 or higher
- Be a woman of African American heritage.
- Not be related to a member of The National Coalition of 100 Black Women Inc. Bergen / Passaic Chapter.

*Some scholarships are available to freshmen students already attending Community colleges or 4 year colleges.

Application:

The application and all supporting documents can be found below and should be forwarded via U.S. mail:

- Completed application
- Official transcript
- Two letters of recommendation
- An essay
- SAT/ACT scores
- Senior year graduation picture

- Proof of permanent residency or citizenship in the USA
- Proof of legal residency in Bergen or Passaic County, NJ for at least one year prior to the application.

The application and all supporting documents must be postmarked by Friday, March 13, 2020.
